## Sellars Creek Ranch Trek Operation Dedicatory Prayer

We are thankful for those who have served so diligently, and yes have even sacrificed, for the building of the various features of this place, but especially for their spiritual devotion to build the spiritual nature of this place.

And so we humbly approach Thee and petition Thee to hear our prayer this day — our prayer of dedication. Heavenly Father, by the authority of the Holy Melchizedek Priesthood that I bear, and acting under the direction and authorization of the leadership of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, I dedicate this the Sellars Creek Ranch Trek Operation to the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to serve as an official trek site for youth and families that live in the valley — that have ears to hear and needs to come here— for the blessings that it will provide to them.

I dedicate all of the physical structures, the office, and the trek storage building for the very purpose of trek and to contribute to the cattle operation that we have here. I dedicate the water system, the well, the electrical, the campsites, the roadways, the parking areas, the groves of trees, the open meadows, the streams, the mountains that provide vistas and views— to be used to grow faith and testimony in the modern pioneers who will come here.

We bless this place that it will be protected against the negative elements and influences that seem to swirl—and perhaps at times will come close. We call upon Thee to keep this place safe, and to preserve its functionality through the length of time that Thou would have this.

We are grateful to have dedicated Church Service Missionaries. I pronounce a blessing upon each of those who have served here, who have consecrated their abilities, their talents, resources, and their time. I pronounce a blessing upon them, upon their children, upon their families. We will be eternally grateful for all that they have done, as we know Thou art.

We ask a blessing upon those who will serve here as Church Service Missionaries through this winter in preparation for spring and the many springs to follow. Please bless them with a similar blessing that they will be magnified, capable, strengthened in their health, in their families, in their lives and in their testimonies that they may be able to serve here with honor.

Now it would be important this day, knowing that many will come, to extend a blessing to those in the valley that have needs and circumstances that this trek site would be a blessing and a benefit to. We extend a blessing to their leaders that they will be able to identify the needs that their youth and their families may have, and then come here— and find a way to build an experience that will touch them and bless them in the ways, the very specific ways, they have needs to be filled.

And so we ask that Thy spirit might go forward and stir the hearts of those that could benefit, and that they will be blessed so that when they come here they will come with intent and purpose and needs, and that their prayers will be answered that they may experience perhaps the greatest miracle of all that this project can provide—and that is to change the hearts of Thy children—that their testimonies might be strengthened, that they might be humble and grateful, and that when they return to their homes they will have a sacred testimony and recollection, and that they will be a better people.

I ask a blessing upon this property that the welfare project that is part of this ranch—that the cows and calves that come here—that they will prosper and help fulfill the needs of Thy children in many places.
